ABOUT CAMP TANASI



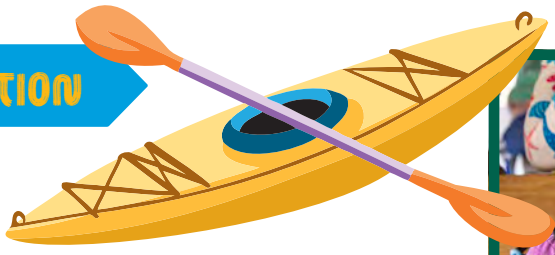
123 Dark Hollow Rd N, Andersonville, TN 37705
Camp Tanasi is located on Norris Lake with 461 acres of wooded property, cabins, and tents. Activities are offered at a waterfront program area, swimming pool, archery range, and climbing tower. There is also a craft cabin, dining hall, and amphitheater. PLUS, Tanasi is accredited by the American Camp Association!



WHERE DO CAMPERS STAY?

- ▶ 1st-3rd Graders: Deerpoint, a three-season cabin with bunkbeds and mattresses.
- ▶ 4th-5th Graders: Echo Cove, platform cabins with bunkbeds, mattresses, and AC.
- ▶ 6th-8th Graders: Cedars, platform tents with cots and mattresses.
- ▶ CITs: Deep Woods, cabins (with AC) and platform tents, with beds and mattresses.

The average price for one week at other overnight camps in our region is \$1,207. Thanks to the Girl Scout Cookie Program, our summer camp is one of the most affordable options available! Girls can also apply Cookie Dough or Candy Cash to their balance for summer camp.

If your family needs further assistance paying for your Girl Scout to attend, limited camp scholarships are available for all our summer programs EXCEPT Me and Mine Camp, A Team!, and Horse Camp. 2024 SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM OFFERINGS & DATES

WEEK 1

JUNE 9-14

Rising 2nd - 12th graders

Me and Mine Camp

June 9-11 | \$400 per person

Do you ever wish you could attend summer camp along with your girl? This program is perfect for you and your Girl Scout! Campers along with an adult female relative or friend will get to explore Camp Tanasi and try the following activities: badge work, crafts, swimming, and lake-front activities. All campers must be accompanied by a female adult at least 18 years of age. Separate registration is required for girl and adult campers.

Rising 8th - 10th graders

Wilderness

June 9-14 | \$700

During Wilderness, campers sleep in camping hammocks in a primitive outdoor unit with access to potable water. Each camper will be able to participate in traditional camp activities in the morning with other campers and then go back to their unit for activities that teach knife usage, lashing, wild facility use, campfire cooking, and more. Dinner each day will be cooked in the unit while lunch and breakfast will be with the rest of the campers in the dining hall. This program is great for both beginner and experienced campers but is recommended for girls with at least one year of camp under their belts.

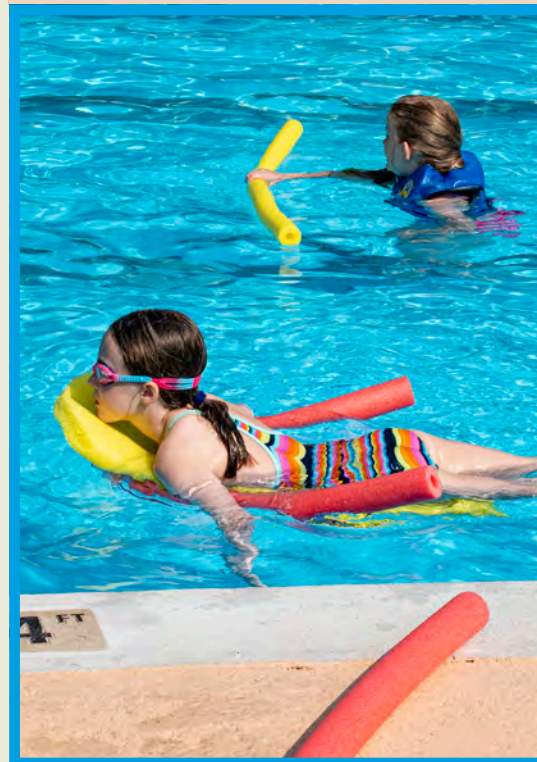
JUNE 16-21

Counselor-In-Training (CIT) II is also one of our most popular programs and helps campers continue to build on their leadership skills. Campers will participate in and help facilitate many camp activities under the supervision of certified staff, learning what makes a great camp counselor along the way! CIT II campers stay for THREE WEEKS and over two weekends. CAMPERS MUST HAVE ALREADY COMPLETED CIT I BEFORE APPLYING FOR CIT II.

About Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Programs

What is Counselor-In-Training (CIT)? It's a challenging and fun program that builds skills and experiences to prepare campers to be future camp counselors. The Counselor-In-Training program teaches decision making, goal setting, teamwork, flexibility, and empathy. It provides practical, meaningful experiences in a safe and nurturing environment. CITs gain expertise in leadership, program planning, and implementation, as well as working with younger campers. CIT is an earned leadership award with Girl Scouts.

All participants in the CIT program stay in a three-season lodge on either bunk beds or spring metal cots. Over the weekend(s), they have access to laundry facilities. They may bring snacks and electronics to keep in their sleeping unit in preparation for being a counselor.

IMPORTANT! To participate in a Counselor-In-Training (CIT) program, campers must successfully complete an application and interview. All CIT I and CIT II candidates should first register for their preferred session. Prospective CIT I and CIT II campers must then complete and submit an application for their preferred session. Applications will be available online at time of registration. CIT I and CIT II candidates will be contacted to schedule an interview after their application is received. A refund will be issued if a camper is not accepted into the CIT program.

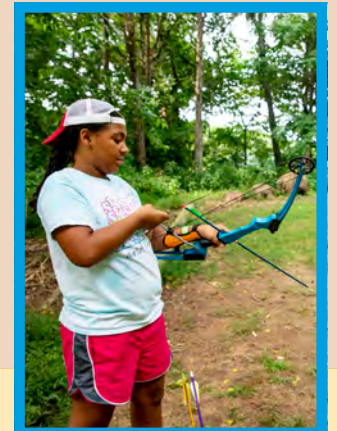
