

CAMP ADAHI GENERAL INFORMATION



NO DRUGS, ALCOHOL, WEAPONS OR PETS

ALLOWED ON CAMP ADAHI PROPERTY.

CAMP ADAHI IS A SMOKE-FREE ENVIRONMENT

RESERVATION POLICY – Reservations are on a first come first served basis. You may reserve a weekend up to one year in advance. To reserve camp you will need to include:

- **Camp Adahi reservation form**
 - If the unit or date chosen is not available, the leader will be notified by the Camp Registrar of other units and or dates that are available
 - If the unit and date chosen is available, a confirmation packet will be mailed to the Leader within (7) days of receipt
- **\$100 damage deposit**
 - A separate check from fees
 - Damage deposit will be refunded as long as the camp site is left clean, no damages have occurred, and when the Adahi check-out survey has been filled in and returned
- **Cabin and/or tent fees in full**

FEES – Fees are determined on the basis of operating costs and are subject to annual review. The current fee schedule is printed on the Camp Adahi Reservation Form. A troop may have additional fees occur if there are damages to property that should exceed the \$100 damage deposit.

REFUNDS – All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable two weeks prior to troop camping date.

- Weather refund policy: we will refund all fees **only if camp closes due to weather.**
- Activity fees will be refunded if GSCSA cancels the activity due to weather, or any other event that deemed the activity unsafe for participants.
- Other refund requests must be submitted to the camp registrar in writing.

SAFETY – All Camp Adahi visitors are required to abide by all of the **Safety Activity Points** guidelines. These can be found on our GSCSA website.

CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS – At least one person attending must have Troop Camp Basics training and one person attending must be First Aid certified.

ADDITIONAL INSURANCE POLICY – Insurance for participants who are not registered Girl Scouts must be purchased **two weeks** prior to camp date. Forms are available on-line or at your local GSCSA office.

CHECK-IN and CHECK-OUT TIME – Check-in time is 5:00-7:00 pm EST. Friday afternoon. Saturday check-in time must be noted on reservation for Rangers to have gates unlocked for your arrival. Check-out time for all campsites is no later than 12 noon on Sunday.

ADAHI FACILITIES

Tent Units – Talahi, Karakondye & Pooh Corner

Each unit has ten tents on platforms (12' by 14')

Each tent sleeps 4

Each unit sleeps 40

Units have a play area for games and outdoor wash house

Cabin Units – Unalyi and Ahwenasa

These units each have five cabins

Each cabin sleeps 16

Each unit sleeps 80

Cabins have a porch/lounge area and bathroom/shower

Oneida Bass Staff House – Kitchen facilities, bathroom/shower, sleeps 10, porch

ADDITIONAL UNIT ACCOMODATIONS

Talahi and Unalyi – Have a troop house (assembly room with fireplace), tables/benches, kitchen with refrigerator and wood cooking stove.

Karakondye and Ahwenasa – Have open pavilion troop shelters, built-in wood cooking stoves/charcoal grills, picnic tables and refrigerators.

Pooh Corner – Has an open pavilion troop shelter, wood cooking stove, picnic tables and refrigerator.

Note: Bring coolers to store your food.

You may be sharing unit houses including the stove and refrigerator.

Outdoor Wash House – Hand washing facilities, flush toilets (water is turned off from November to March or according to weather: latrines are available; water is brought in, but troops need to bring drinking water).

Open Fields – Large open fields are available for sports and games

BUILDINGS

Dining Hall – This building may only be used for day or evening activities. Kitchen is not accessible.

Infirmary – To be used by First Aid personnel only.

Kitchen – Furnished with commercial food preparation equipment.
