## **100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, Rock the Mall Washington, DC Trip**

### **Day 1: Thursday, June 7, 2012**

*Motor Coach and Hotel*

You will depart your designated city and place at 8:00am sharp! Bathroom breaks and optional fast food stops made at the discretion of the Lead Troop Coordinator on your motor coach. A Class Act Tours Representative will meet you at your hotel upon arrival to assist with check in. ***First 400 who sign up will stay at the Westin Hotel, Tyson's Corner, Tele: 703 893-1340; Remaining troops will stay at alternate hotel, TBA.***

### **Day 2: Friday, June 8, 2012**

*Motor Coach, Hotel, B, L & D, Personal Tour Guide*

**Breakfast** is provided your hotel. Your Tour Guide will meet you at breakfast. You will enjoy viewing the **White House** from **President's Park** and you will visit the **White House Museum**. This morning, you will have a special tour of the **Capitol Visitor's Center and the US Capitol**. (*Meeting with your State Representative requested and based on their schedule. They will confirm 2 weeks prior to arrival*). After your Capitol Hill adventure, you will enjoy lunch at **National Place Food Court**; (*prepaid food vouchers will be provided*). After Lunch, I could stay here forever." Mid-afternoon, you will visit the **Holocaust Museum** and watch a film. The museum is dedicated to the people that were systematically killed by the German Nazis during World War II. Over 6,000,000 people were killed. They included Jews, Roma (Gypsies), Jehovah's witnesses and political enemies of the Nazis. You will have the opportunity to walk through Daniels story, a narrative of the Holocaust told from a young boy's perspective. You will continue with your Personal Tour Guide to visit our famous **Memorials**, including a visit to the Newest Memorial in DC, the **Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial!** Other memorials will include: The **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**, better known as "**The Wall**". You will also visit The **Lincoln Memorial**, which overlooks the Reflecting Pool and was patterned on a classic Greek Temple. Inside, inscriptions from his **Gettysburg Address** and **Second Inaugural Address** flank the 19-foot marble statue of our 16th President. Before finishing your day, you will visit **The Extra Mile — Points of Light Volunteer Pathway, to view and take pictures of the Juliette Gordon Low Medallion**. You will enjoy **dinner at the Old Post Office Pavilion**, (*Prepaid meal vouchers provided--This place has veggie wraps and gourmet salads for vegetarians!!*) (*Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Provided*)

### **Day 3: Saturday, June 9, 2012**

*Motor coach, B&D, Hotel provided*

**Breakfast provided at hotel.** Today will be dedicated to the "**ROCK the MALL**" event, in which you will enjoy a Girl Scout sing along, guest speakers and Special Activities! You will have the opportunity to

meet other Girl Scout Troops from around the country! You will also have the opportunity to visit at your leisure your choice of any famous **Smithsonian Museums** on the Capitol Mall such as the **American National History Museum, National Museum of the American Indian, the Air and Space Museum, (where you can enjoy a Scavenger Hunt),** and visit the **Natural History Museum. Lunch** on your own at the many cafes located on the Capitol Mall. **Group A** will enjoy a **pizza dinner on a Potomac Cruise. Group B** will enjoy **Dinner at the National Place Food Court with Prepaid Meal Vouchers provided. (Lunch Pizza Cruise provided to Group B on Sunday) (Breakfast and Dinner Provided)**

## **Day 4: Sunday, June 10, 2012**

*Motor Coach, B&L, Personal Tour Guide*

**Breakfast provided at your hotel. After breakfast, you will visit Arlington Cemetery.** You will learn about many sites in the cemetery, such as the **Kennedy grave sites** where President John Kennedy and his family are buried, which is also the location of the **Eternal Flame**. There are a number of places in the vicinity of the Amphitheater which include: **the Tomb of the Unknowns, Audie Murphy's grave and the Memorial to the USS Main,** which was the mission to rescue hostages from the Tehran, Iran embassy. You will witness the **Changing of the Guards** lay a Special Wreath at the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.** The next and final site at Arlington is the **Arlington House (Curtis-Lee Mansion).** The recently restored mansion is a memorial to Robert E. Lee. **The grave of Pierre L'Enfant,** the French engineer who designed the city of Washington, is located at the front of the house. Just days before his assassination President John Kennedy stood at the front of the house and remarked, "This is the most beautiful place in the world. **Group A** will enjoy lunch at the **National Food Court** with prepaid meal vouchers included. **Group B** will enjoy a **Potomac Cruise pizza lunch,** prior to departing DC. Your motor coach will start the drive back home with fond memories of your Rock the Mall adventure to our Nation's Capital. You will arrive back in Tennessee around midnight, exact times TBA. *(Breakfast and Lunch provided. Fast food dinner stop and bathroom stops at discretion of Lead Troop Coordinator on Motor coach.)*
