To Earn:

- Brownies do four activities including requirement one and two.

- Cadettes & Seniors do eight activities including requirement one and two.
 1. View a filmstrip regarding a Prehistoric Indian Village or Dig Site from the public library or your school.
 2. Learn what archaeology sites teach us and how the findings help scientists.
 3. Tour an archaeology site and write a report on what you saw and learned.
 4. Make a model of an early Indian dwelling (not a Tepee).
 5. Make a clay pot and fire it the way the Indians did.
 6. Make a sketch of houses or tools used by early people.
 7. Write a report about the various crops raised by early people.
 8. Learn to map a digging.
 9. Help dig at a site for two (2) hours.
 10. Visit with either a past or present archaeologist about their digs and what they have learned about early history.
 11. Learn about another archaeology site in another state and write about what they found.
