

## **The Service Center**

The service center patch is designed to commemorate a troop's visit to the council headquarters in Johnson City. When troops complete their tour of the service center, they earn a patch representing all they learned during their visit. Troops are welcome at the service center!

### **Requirements:**

#### **BROWNIES**

Do two of the following, including the one marked with an asterisk (\*).

- \*1. Take a guided tour of the Service Center, given by a Council staff member or volunteer.
2. Take a tour of Camp Wildwood, weather permitting.
3. Answer the following: Leaders, ask your girls these questions upon completion of their tour.
  - A. What is the name of your Girl Scout council?
  - B. What special things does your council do?
  - C. What happens in the conference room?
  - D. What is the name of the camp at the service center?
  - E. What room has Girl Scout books, films and slides?
  - F. What do you find in the equipment shop?

#### **JUNIORS**

Do four of the following, including the ones marked with an asterisk(\*).

- \*1. Take a guided tour of the service center conducted by a council staff member or volunteer.
2. Take a tour of Camp Wildwood (weather permitting).
- \*3. Complete requirement one, Girl Scouting Everywhere.
4. Complete requirement six, Girl Scouting Everywhere.
- \*5. Look through the library for resources you might like to use in other Girl Scout activities.

#### **CADETTES**

Do four of the following, including the ones marked asterisk (\*).

- \*1. Take a guided tour of the service center conducted by a council staff member or volunteer
2. Take a tour of Camp Wildwood, weather permitting.
- \*3. Complete requirement four, Hands Around the World.
4. Discuss ways in which you might complete requirement two, Hands Around the World.
- \*5. List as many professional council positions as you can and describe which you would like to have.

#### **SENIORS**

Do three of the following, including the ones marked (\*).

- \*1. Take a guided tour of the service center conducted by a council staff member or volunteer.
2. Take a tour of Camp Wildwood, weather permitting.
3. Choose one Council staff person and briefly discuss with that person their job and its duties.
- \*4. Find ways to participate in Council activities that will help satisfy requirements for Silver or Gold Award.

#### **ADULTS**

1. Schedule troop tour at least one week in advance.
2. Plan on a 20 minute tour of the building and 30 minutes at camp.
3. Remind girls to be courteous and quiet while in the service center, as it is a place of work, too.
4. Allow time for browsing through the library, shopping, or walking through the camp (weather permitting).
