

My Family Loves Girl Scouting

All Age Levels



The **My Family Loves Girl Scouting Patch Program** is designed to promote family involvement in the Girl Scout experience while providing parents and caregivers an understanding of Girl Scouting and the many opportunities available to both girls and adults. Some of the activities will be completed in partnership with your Girl Scout and some activities will be completed with her group.

Requirements: A girl must have at least one adult family member or friend register with her group. If the girl's family accumulates at least 75 points during the year, the girl is entitled to purchase a "My Family Loves Girl Scouting" patch. For subsequent years in which the girl's family earns the minimum number of points, the girl is entitled to purchase a rocker for her patch. Patches and rockers will be for sale at the Girl Scout Shop.

A family may elect to begin participation at any program level.

PARENT ACTIVITIES AND POINTS

- ___ Group Cookie Manager or Nut Sale Manager (35 points)
- ___ Obtain certification for troop First Aide, Outdoor Training, or Lifeguard and accompany the troop when needed. (25 points)
- ___ Plan and coordinate activities for the troop to complete a try-it or badge (25 points)
- ___ Plan and coordinate a service project for the group (25 points)
- ___ Plan and coordinate the group's Thinking Day activities (25 points)
- ___ Plan and coordinate the troop investiture or award ceremony. (15 points)
- ___ Help plan a campout or field trip for the group (15 points)
- ___ Attend a Girl Scout family event in your troop or service unit. (15 points)
- ___ Attend 2 or more troop meetings and assist with activities. (15 points)
- ___ Share a skill, talent or hobby with the group or group of leaders in your area, or arrange for a speaker (15 points)
- ___ Help your child earn a try-it, badge or patch at home. (15 points)
- ___ Take your Girl Scout to a council or service unit event even if the troop is not attending. (10 points)
- ___ Work with your Girl Scout to familiarize yourself with the requirements for Girl Scout awards. Keep a record of extra curricular activities that will help her earn awards outside the regular troop activities. (15 points)
- ___ Chaperone a group field trip or campout (10 points)
- ___ Attend a Service Unit meeting with or for your group leader (10 points)
- ___ Provide child care for your leader to attend a meeting / training (10 points)
- ___ Help with group telephoning or newsletter (5 points)
- ___ Bring snacks or supplies for a meeting (5 points)
- ___ Help with paperwork or record keeping during a meeting (5 points)
- ___ Other assistance as needed by troop leader (point value assigned by troop leader)
