How can you get involved?

Troop Administrator

Manage the administrative tasks for the troop (such as registration, participation records, and activity approvals), and facilitate communication between parents, council staff, and the other parents in the troop.

Girl Program Mentor

Facilitate girl-led planning and run program activities for one or more grade levels. Plan meetings using our easy-to-use Volunteer Toolkit and organize outings and activities for the girls.

Troop Outdoor Coordinator

Ensure that outdoor activities are a part of the program. May serve in a lead role when the troop goes camping or does outdoor activities.

Troop Treasurer

Set up and maintain troop banking records. Provide regular updates to the parents in the troop regarding the troop finances, and submit required financial paperwork each year.

Troop Product Manager

Organize and manage the troop product sales, including receiving and distributing materials, products, payments and incentives.

Episodic Volunteer

Assist as needed, for as little or as much time as you want. Support troop meetings, share your knowledge for a skill workshop, sew badges on uniforms, sort product – whatever your skill, we can use you!


