Mostly A's: **red** or **blue** personality. Mostly C's: **orange** or **yellow** personality.
Mostly B's: **purple** personality. Mostly D's: **green** personality.

You run toward opportunity, ready to tackle any challenge.</p>	<p>An orange personality is all about fun! You are a risk-taker, an energetic, active, outgoing, person. You're often seen as an extrovert and usually need lots of room to explore your interests, otherwise you get bored. You may struggle with doing things that feel like work instead of play, but your exuberance and energy can help you be successful.</p>	<p>If you have a yellow personality, you're probably easygoing, fun to be around, committed, and kind. You can also be indecisive, though, since you don't want to disappoint anyone, and you take criticism to heart. You encourage others and are good at communicating your ideas. Just watch out and don't get into trouble for being the class clown!</p>	<p>People with green personalities tend to be all about the big picture! You can seem introverted, enjoying your own space to create and think, but also work well in groups to get projects done. You like to ask "But, why?" about things and sometimes question authority which can get you into trouble. You are a visionary and want to make sure everything is fair.</p>	<p>People with blue personalities are driven and determined. You tend to be a perfectionist and want things done the "right" way which can be difficult, but you care deeply about a job well done. You take pride in your work and want others to appreciate it. Like green personalities, you want to make sure everything is fair, and you expect greatness from yourself as well as from others.</p>	<p>People with purple personalities are often highly creative introverts. You likely prefer to be left to your own devices instead of running with a crowd and can be highly empathetic. You may even be able to know how people are feeling without them even saying anything! You tend to avoid conflict and let your emotions drive you and inspire your actions.</p>
