You like to ask “But, why?” about things and sometimes question authority which can get you into trouble. You are a visionary and want to make sure everything is fair.	An orange personality is all about fun! You are a risk-taker, an energetic, active, outgoing, person. You’re often seen as an extrovert and usually need lots of room to explore your interests, otherwise you get bored. You may struggle with doing things that feel like work instead of play, but your exuberance and energy can help you be successful.	If you’re a yellow personality, you’re probably easygoing, fun to be around, committed, and kind. You can also be indecisive, though, since you don’t want to disappoint anyone, and you take criticism to heart. You encourage others and are good at communicating your ideas. Just watch out and don’t get in trouble for being the class clown!	People with blue personalities are driven and determined. You tend to be a perfectionist and want things done the “right” way which can be difficult, but you care deeply about a job well done. Like green personalities, you want to make sure everything is fair, and you expect greatness from yourself as well as from others.	A red personality likes to take charge. You are a go-getter, leader, and doer. This means you can also be really competitive and demanding, but if a job needs done, you’re the person! You are often spontaneous and passionate, likely thinking fast and acting fast, and are driven to succeed. You run toward opportunity, ready to tackle any challenge.	People with purple personalities are often highly creative introverts. You likely prefer to be left to your own devices instead of running with a crowd and can be highly empathetic. You may even be able to know how people are feeling without them even saying anything! You tend to avoid conflict and let your emotions drive you and inspire your actions.
